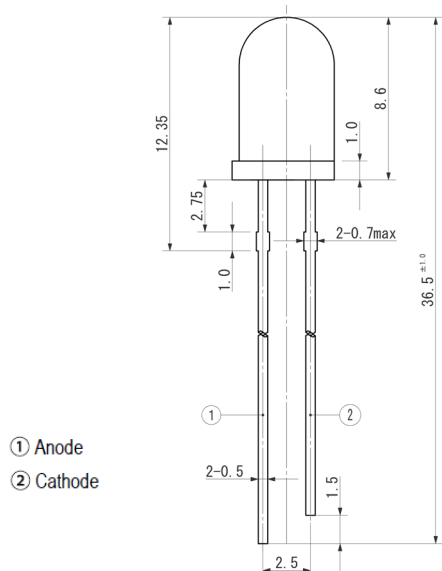

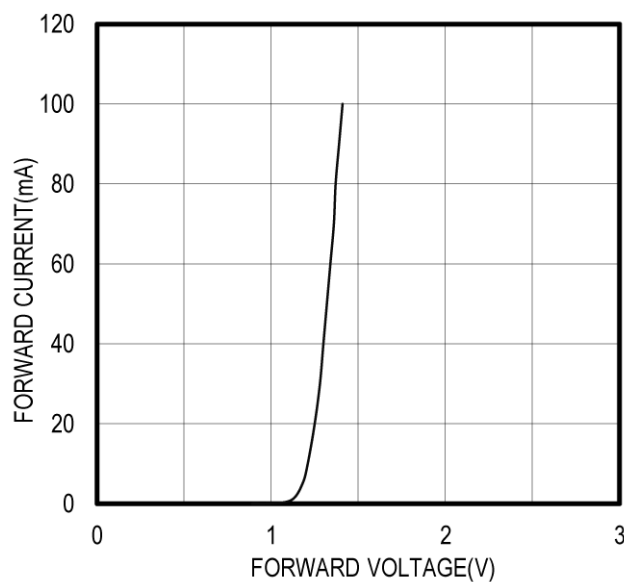

SPECTRAL OUTPUT



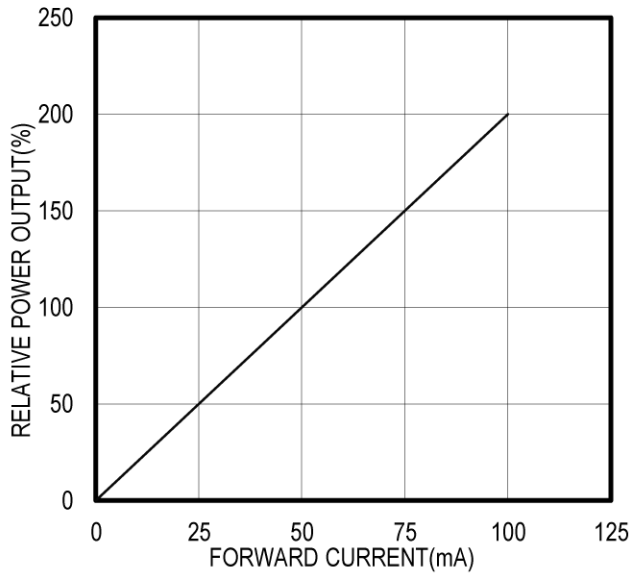
FORWARD I-V CHARACTERISTICS



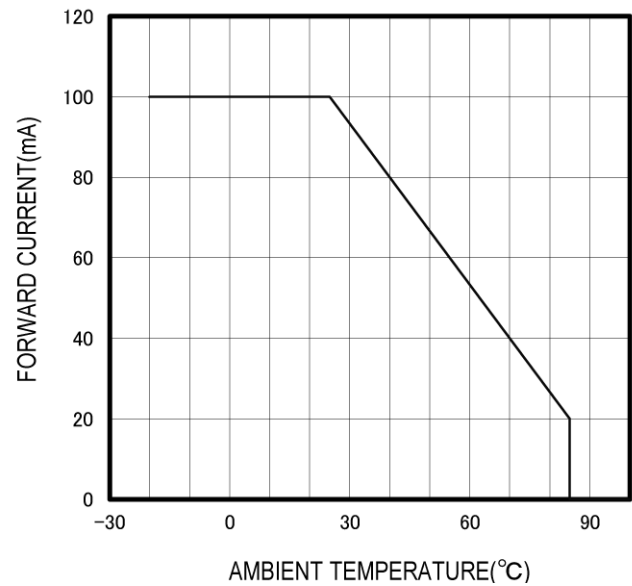

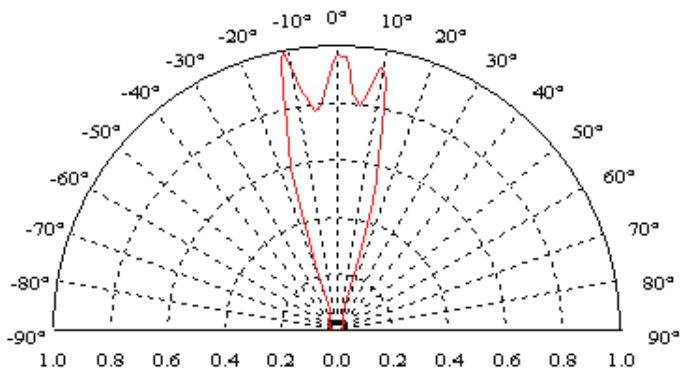
RELATIVE POWER vs FORWARD CURRENT
